Mission Statement: *The mission of the aesthetics committee is to provide an attractive space that will enhance our service and activity experiences and project our shared UU principles. We aim to provide visual interest and create a church home that is more than utilitarian, that which is warm and inviting, comforting, coordinated and aesthetically pleasing, and lovingly cared for.*

Hang banners and pulpit cloth as deemed by the season and create or update items.

Develop and place seasonal items in sanctuary for specific services, such as fallen leaves garland, water communion, trellis, etc. and others as requested by staff and worship committee.

Care for plants within the building: scheduled watering; moving, rehabilitating, replanting as necessary. Coordinate sanctuary floral arrangements via sign ups from donors, purchase and arrange. Re-arrange and dispose as warranted.

Consult with individuals, staff, and other committees regarding aesthetic result of changes to building. Act on needs as they arise.

Improve visual quality of building via coordinated surface usage (signage, art, other hanging) to depict an organized effort. Monitor/recommend areas of rehabilitation.
