

Religious Education Committee Description

In general, the Religious Education Committee works in close collaboration with the Director of Religious Education to set the direction for the children's RE Program and to implement the program. In addition, RE Committee members may assist other committees such as Sunday Services in planning and implementing their activities that involve children and youth.

Specific RE committee duties include:

1. Serve as *Good Fairy* (see Good Fairy Description); greet and register new families, and help children and teachers as needed (bring children to their class, the bathroom, to their parents etc. if needed).
2. Sunday announcements and newsletter articles to keep the Fellowship informed of RE concerns, activities and accomplishments.
3. Assist in maintenance of RE space and supplies. For example, help set up and tear down classrooms.
4. Recruit RE teachers, RE Youth Group leaders, RE Committee members, and RE representative for Intergenerational Committee.
5. Plan and carry out, with volunteer assistance, social activities for children.
6. Develop and monitor annual committee budgets (RE Program, Child Care, DRE).
7. Consult with DRE on curriculum plan.
8. Lead children's services for RE Group Activity Days.
9. Assist in hiring Sunday childcare providers.
10. Participate in annual evaluation of DRE's job performance.
