

## 2009-2010 Religious Education Curricula

- ❖ **Preschool**—*Celebrating Me and My World*. This curriculum provides preschoolers with experiences and opportunities to grow in their sense of trust and caring and to develop their self-identity and their sense of connectedness with all of life.
- ❖ **Kindergarten-Grade 1**—*Treasure Hunting*. This curriculum involves children in the excitement of the search for meaning in life. Each week through games, crafts, songs and stories the children explore the meaning behind a Unitarian Universalist principle or value.
- ❖ **Grades 2-3**—*A Stepping-Stone Year*. This curriculum addresses children who are taking their first structured steps in forming religious identities and concepts. It draws upon science, myth, Unitarian and Universalist traditions and other secular and spiritual resources to support children in this inquiry.
- ❖ **Grades 4-5**—*Holidays and Holy Days*. This curriculum engages children to learn about the origins and meanings of holidays and holy day celebrations.
- ❖ **Grades 6, 7, 8**—*Neighboring Faiths*. This curriculum introduces our youth to the faith traditions and practices of other religious groups in our community.
