Religious Education Curriculum

Pre-School

Chalice Children: *Based on the premise that children learn best through experience, this program helps nurture spiritual growth, creativity and a sense of community through imaginative activities and rituals such as rhymes and fingerplays.*

Grade K-1

Tapestry of Faith Curriculum – Creating Home: *This program helps children develop a sense of home that is grounded in faith.*

Grade 2-3

Fall: Eco Team: *A custom curriculum on eco-awareness and a focus on the 7th principle of Unitarian Universalism.*

Spring: We Believe: *This program emphasizes learning and living our Unitarian Universalist Principles*

Grade 4-5

Fall: Travel In Time: *This program uses time travel to help participants explore their religious identity and the lives of individual past and present who exemplify our faith.*

Spring: Tapestry of Faith Curriculum – Toolbox of Faith: *This program invites participants to reflect on qualities of our Unitarian Universalist faith, such as integrity, courage and love, as tools they can use in living their lives and building their own faith.*

Grade 6-8

Fall: Backpacker's Notebook: *This program explores Unitarian Universalist Faith and Community in a question and exploration format.*

Spring: Tapestry of Faith Curriculum – Families: *Who is in a family varies widely and contributes to the diversity of healthy variation. This is a photo documentary curriculum.*
